

# Guidelines for Different Scholarships under State Govt. Schemes

**Code- JM:- Junior Merit Scholarship:-**

Students should have passed 10<sup>th</sup> Std. Examination, 2009 conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Orissa/CBSE/ICSC and have secured 60% or more marks and have taken admission in +2 Ist year during 2009 in any Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State. There is no income ceiling of parents for award of this scholarship. This scholarship shall be awarded for a period of two years @Rs. 40/- per month. Renewal of the scholarship for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year is subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee during Ist year and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix-D** by the Principal of the concerned College. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code- SM:- Senior Merit Scholarship:-**

Students should have passed +2 Exam, 2009 conducted by CHSE, Orissa/CBSE/ICSE and have secured 60% or more marks and have taken admission in +3 Ist year during 2009 in any Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State. There is no income ceiling of parents for award of this scholarship. This scholarship shall be awarded for a period of three years @Rs. 50/- per month. The renewal of the scholarship for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years are subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee during Ist year/II<sup>nd</sup> year and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix-D** by the Principal of the concerned College. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code- PM:- PG Merit Scholarship:-**

Students should have passed +3 Final Year with Hons. in the Annual Exam, 2009 from any of the Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State, secured 60% or more marks and have taken admission in Ist year MA/M.Sc./M.Com during 2009 in any Autonomous College/University of the State. Students continuing PG courses in OUAT can also apply for this scholarship. However, students pursuing PG course in other professional courses are not eligible for award under this scheme. Applicants should have taken admission in the PG class in a subject which he/she had taken as honors at the undergraduate level. Students studying PG course in a subject outside Orissa for which teaching facilities are available inside the State are not eligible for award of this scholarship. There is no income ceiling of parents. This scholarship is awarded @ Rs. 60/- per month and is tenable for a period of two years. The renewal of the scholarship for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year is subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee during 1<sup>st</sup> year and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix-D** by the concerned Principal/ Registrar/Head of the Institution. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code- JP:- Junior Merit-cum-Poverty Scholarship:-**

Students should have passed in the 10<sup>th</sup> standard Examination, 2009 conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Orissa/CBSE/ICSE securing 50% or more marks and have taken admission in +2 1<sup>st</sup> year in any Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State are eligible for this scholarship. The annual income of percents from all sources shall not exceed Rs. 24,000/-. This scholarship shall be awarded for a period

of two years @ 40/- per month. The renewal for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year is subject to satisfactory performance & good conduct of the awardee during 1<sup>st</sup> year and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix-D** by the Principal of the concerned College. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code-SP :- Senior Merit-cum-Poverty Scholarship :-**

Students should have passed +2 Annual Exam., 2009 conducted by CHSE, Orissa securing 50% or more marks and have taken admission in +3 1<sup>st</sup> year in a Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State are eligible to apply for award of this scholarship. The Annual income of parents from all sources shall not exceed Rs. 24,000/-. This scholarship will be awarded for a period of 3 yrs. @ Rs.50/- per month. The renewal for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years are subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee during 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year, respectively, and submission of renewal proposal as in APPENDIX – D by the Principal of the concerned College. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code-PP:- PG Merit-cum-Poverty Scholarship :-**

Students should have passed +3 Annual Exam. during 2009 with Honours/and have secured 50% or more marks & have taken admission in PG course in the subject which he/she had taken as honours at undergraduate stage. Students studying PG course in a subject in an Institution outside Orissa for which teaching facility is available inside the State are not eligible. The annual income of parents shall not exceed Rs. 24,000/-. This scholarship will be awarded for a period of two years @ Rs. 60/- per month. The renewal for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year is subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix –D** by the Principal of the concerned College. The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code –STC:- Scholarship to Children of Primary/Secondary School Teachers :-**

Students should have passed the 10<sup>th</sup> Std. Annual Exam., 2009, conducted by BSE, Orissa/CBSE/ICSE securing 60% or more marks and have taken admission in +2 1<sup>st</sup> year in a Govt./recognized Non-Govt. College of the State. This scholarship is tenable till completion of PG/Technical course subject to satisfactory performance and good conduct of the awardee in proceeding years (courses) and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix –D** by the Principal of the concerned College. The rate of scholarship at different stage for day scholars /hostellers are given below.

The common application form for award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code-TC:- Scholarship to Meritorious Girl Students Prosecuting Technical/ Professional / Management Studies.**

This scholarship will be awarded to meritorious girl students who are the **permanent residents** of Orissa and have passed the qualifying examination from an Educational Institution **located within the state of Orissa** and have secured admission during 2009 in the specified course in the specified Institution of Higher

Technical/Professional / Management studies, given herein after, provided that their parental income(income of both father and mother) does not exceed Rs. 1,50,000/- from all sources in the year proceeding the year of admission (i.e. ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2009). This scholarship is awarded at the rate of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month for the entire duration of the course subject to fulfillment of terms and conditions laid down in Govt. resolution No. 65763 dr. 28.11.2000 and as amended by resolution No.68750 dt.27.12.03 of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Orissa. The Common Application Form for Award of scholarship (CAFAS) should be used for applying.

**Code-~~TM~~- Merit- cum- Means Scholarship to Students Prosecuting Degree Level Course in Engineering/ Medical/ Dental Sciences.**

This Scholarship will be awarded to meritorious students of Orissa who have secured admission in Technical / Medical Institutions inside or outside the State or in a Institute of National repute in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in Govt. of Orissa, Department of Higher Education resolution No. 33500/HE dt.24.10.2008 and as may be issued by the Govt. from time to time.

Eligible students are required to apply in prescribed Common Application Form for Award of Scholarship (CAFAS) only.

**1. Institutions in which this Scholarship may be made available.**

Orissa students pursuing studies in any Technical/Medical Institution enacted by State Legislation of Orissa or recognized by All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) or University Grants Commission (UGC) or by respective State Legislations shall be eligible to come under the purview of this scheme subject to fulfillment of other conditions.

**2. Eligibility criteria**

- (i) The student must be a permanent resident of Orissa
- (ii) The annual income of parents from all sources shall not exceed Rs. 2.5 lakhs.
- (iii) A student already in receipt of any other scholarship cannot avail this scholarship unless he/she opts to forgo the other scholarship.

**3. Procedure of selection.**

- i) All the eligible students ( both boys & girls) pursuing MBBS and BDS course in the Medical College situated inside the State shall be awarded this Scholarship. Selection will be made purely on the basis of the rank obtained by a student in the Joint Entrance Examination(JEE), conducted by the Director, Technical Education and Training, Orissa.
- ii) Eligible students of Orissa pursuing degree courses in Engineering, MBBS & BDS in National Institutes of repute e.g; All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)/ Jawaharlal Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education and Research (JIPMER), Pondicherry / Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC), Pune/ Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) /Indian Institute of Science (IIS), Bangalore/ National Institutes of Technology (NITs) etc. shall be awarded this Scholarship on priority basis. While awarding scholarship, income of parents shall be taken into consideration. 1500 scholarships are earmarked for students of the above National Institutions and students admitted on the basis of ranks obtained in All India Tests like IIT/AIEEE/CAT/AIPMT etc. Students from all India Test having lower rank and admitted in professional course in institutions inside or outside the State shall not be eligible to get this scholarship.
- iii) (a) If required number of applications are not available against the number of scholarships allocated for students pursuing MBBS & BDS courses, the balance scholarships shall be made available to the eligible JEE rank holders pursuing Engineering courses in the ratio of Gen-63.76%, Sc- 16.11% & ST-20.13%.  
(b) Similarly, if required number of applications are not available against the scholarships allocated for students pursuing above professional courses in Institutes of National repute, the balance scholarships shall be awarded to JEE(O) rank holders pursuing Engineering course in the ratio stated at (a) above.  
(c) Likewise, in the event of receipt of inadequate number of applications against the allocated number fixed for students of TASP and SCSP area, applications of students belonging to general area pursuing Engineering course shall be considered to utilize the number of scholarships allocated to these specific areas of the State.
- iv) Govt. reserve the right to select or to reject any application for award of this scholarship without assigning any reason thereof.

**4. Distribution of Scholarship**

Scholarships shall be awarded to the following category of students subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria.

#### 5. Award of Scholarship :

- (i) The Director, Higher Education shall prepare category and stream wise merit list of candidates selected for award of scholarship and forward the said list along with the applications to the **Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Orissa** for final and sanction of this scholarship in favour of selected students.
- (ii) The Department of Higher Education will send Bank Draft along with a list of awardees to the concerned authority of the educational institution for disbursement of scholarships.
- (iii) As soon as the scholarship money is available in the educational institution, the same shall be disbursed to the concerned students in shape of account payee cheque. The Head of the Institution shall disburse the scholarship amount and forward the stamped receipt of the concerned student(s) regarding disbursement of scholarship money to the Under Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Orissa, Bhubaneswar within one month of receipt of the scholarship money. The scholarship money that will remain un-disbursed shall be refunded by the Head of the Institution forthwith to the Under Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of Orissa, Bhubaneswar in shape of Bank Draft.

#### 6. Rate and Tenure of the scholarship:

Scholarship shall be paid at the rate of Rs. 10,000/- per annum. This scholarship shall be available for the entire duration of the course subject to following conditions –

- (a) Payment of scholarship shall begin from the date of commencement of the course and shall terminate on the completion of the course, as will be certified by the Head of the Institution where the student is prosecuting his/her studies.
- (b) Scholarship shall be discontinued if the student fails to qualify for promotion to the next higher class.
- (c) The scholarship may also be discontinued at any time on the report of the Head of the Educational Institution that the academic progress and conduct of the concerned student has not been satisfactory. Good conduct shall be a necessary condition of every grant of scholarship.
- (d) Scholarship shall be renewed by the Department of Higher Education from year to year till completion of the course on the certificate of the Head of the Institution that the academic performance and conduct of the scholarship holder have been satisfactory and submission of renewal proposal in **Appendix-D** by the concerned Head of the Institution.
