

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF HIGH POWER COMMITTEE  
CONSTITUTED VIDE GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. 15641/HE DATED  
01.05.2004 HELD ON 22.09.2009 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF  
COMMISSIONER-CUM-SECRETARY TO GOVERNMENT, DEPARTMENT  
OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

1. The meeting of the High Power Committee constituted vide Government Notification No.15641/HE dated 01.05.2004 was held under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Department of Higher Education in his office chamber to consider the proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of general/professional colleges under Section-5 and 6 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969. The Special Secretary to Government in Higher Education Department attended this Committee meeting as a Special invitee as per the desire of the Chairman.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education and the Chairperson of the Committee while initiating discussion indicated that altogether 102 proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of General and Professional Colleges were placed before the committee for consideration. After detailed discussion following decisions were taken.

**2. Opening of New +2 Colleges:**

All together 04 proposals were received from Regional Directors of Education in respect of +2 Colleges. The Committee after detailed discussion decided to defer all cases and RDEs are requested to resubmit the same for the session 2010-11. The list of cases deferred is placed at **Annexure-A**.

**3. Increase of Seats:**

The Department had received 11 proposals for grant of permission to increase seats in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. After detailed discussion, the committee allowed 07 cases, 01 case was deferred and 03 proposals were rejected. The list of cases allowed/deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-B**.

**4. Opening of Honours Subjects:**

All together 32 proposals for opening of Hons. subjects in +3 colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion held in this regard the committee decided to allow 28 cases, 02 cases were rejected and 02 cases were deferred. The list of cases allowed/rejected/deferred is placed at **Annexure-C**.

The decision of HPC dated 27.06.2009 in respect of U.N. Degree College, Soro, Balasore “for increase of seats from 16 to 32 in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology from the session 2009-10 is allowed with the condition as has been prescribed in GO- (ii) of para-11 above” was modified as “increase of seats from 16 to 32 in Hons. in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology in +3 Science from the session 2009-10 is allowed with the condition as has been prescribed in GO- (ii) of para-11 above.”

**5. Opening of New Subjects:**

Proposals for opening of new subject in 21 (+2 and +3) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion the committee allowed 15 cases, 02 cases were deferred and rest 04 cases were rejected. The list of cases allowed/deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-D**.

**6. Opening of New Stream in +2/+3 Colleges:**

The Department had received 18 proposals for opening of new stream in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. The Committee after discussion decided to defer all the cases which may be considered for the session 2010-11.

**7. Opening Permission for New Professional Colleges:**

All together 10 proposals were received from Director, Higher Education for opening of new Private Professional Colleges and Professional Courses in existing colleges. After detailed discussion, the committee allowed 01 case and other 09 cases were deferred indicating reasons against each college. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-E**.

**8. Grant of Permission to Sanskrit Colleges:**

All together 03 cases in respect of Sanskrit Colleges were discussed by the Committee. After detailed discussion, the committee deferred 01 case and other two cases were rejected. The list of cases which are deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-F**.

**9. Grant of Temporary Recognition to Professional Colleges:**

All together 06 proposals were received from Director, Higher Education for grant of Temporary Recognition to Professional Colleges. After detailed discussion the Committee allowed 04 cases and 02 cases were deferred. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-G**.

**10. Grant of Temporary Recognition to +2 College:**

The proposal for antedating temporary recognition from the session 1999-2000 to 1998-99 in respect of +2 Science stream of Anchalika Sahayog College, Subdega, Sundargarh was discussed in pursuance with the order dated 04.05.2009 passed in W.P.(C) No.5131/2009 and order dated 31.07.2009 passed in Misc. Case No.8961/09. After detailed discussion it was decided as follows.

The petitioner's college namely Anchalika Sahayog College, Subdega, Sundargarh was accorded permission to open +2 Science stream with 64 seats from the session 1997-98. As reported, the college could not admit students during 1997-98 and admitted 40 students on 28.07.1998 during the session 1998-99 and 19 students were

admitted on 31.12.1998 during the said session. Thus, altogether 59 students were admitted by the college authority during 1998-99.

The proposal for grant of temporary recognition to +2 Science stream for the session 1998-99 was rejected by the HPC on the ground that the college was not having the requisite land of 7.00 acres and the enrolment position was 40 only as against sanctioned strength of 64. But it is reported that the college was in possession of 6.80 acres of land during 1998-99. Further, as per provision under Sub-Section 2(iii) of Section-11 of Orissa Education Act, 1969, the minimum roll strength of a college should be 32 in Science stream and in case of a college situated in Tribal sub-plan area, the minimum student strength should be 16 in Science stream. The instant college is in Sundargarh district which comes under Tribal sub-plan area.

In view of the above, it appears that the college fulfills the conditions required for grant of temporary recognition for the session 1998-99 and the Committee decided to antedate temporary recognition to +2 Science stream with 64 seats from the session 1999-2000 to 1998-99.

#### **11. General Observation (GOs):**

One general observation (at Sl. xv) is made by the committee in addition to the fourteen general observations already made earlier (Sl. i to Sl. xiv).

- i) Proposals for increase of seats or opening of new stream can only be considered after appearance of at least one batch of students.
- ii) Any new teacher/non-teaching staff required for managing/teaching the students on account of increase of seats be funded out of self financing route. The honorarium/remuneration of these teachers should be at par with other teachers in the college. The college management should give an undertaking and affidavit before taking new students. The H.P.C. observed that this should be followed strictly in view of the restrictions of the Finance Department on account of new appointments.
- iii) The qualification of I.T. lecturers and Computer Science lecturers shall be MCA and B.E. in I.T. or B.E. in Computer Science or MSc (Comp. Science).
- iv) Regarding grant of Temporary Recognition (TR) for back periods, HPC had earlier decided to keep the period as such, but as this is creating problem for the

institutions on continuity of Recognition, the HPC felt it necessary to reverse the earlier decision and allow TR for back periods.

- v) The college/institution has to produce a certificate from Tahasildar regarding location of land and building owned by the college authority for Permanent recognition.
- vi) Permanent recognition would be given in 2-3 years i.e. after passing of one batch of students, if the college fulfills the necessary conditions as provided in the Orissa Education Act, 1969.
- vii) Any permission for opening of new colleges, increase of seats, opening of new stream, opening of new subject and opening of Hons. subjects will be considered by May every year. Similarly for grant of recognition (temporary/ permanent), the colleges/institutions have to apply by the end of August every year which is to be considered in the month of September/October. Thus there would be two phase of HPC in a year, one for Opening Permission and the second for grant of Recognition.
- viii) Five subjects are to be allowed for +3 colleges having 64 seats instead of 4 subjects.
- ix) For opening of new subjects/new streams due to restriction by Finance Department, no new faculty can be recruited by the management. They can run it under self-financing mode like I.T. or Computer Science only. If any college is willing to abide by this condition, it can open a new subject/new stream.
- x) Sanskrit as an 'Elective' subject in +2 Science seems to have been included in 2007 vide notification No. 14019/HE dt. 01.03.2007. As the matter is under reconsideration of Government, all matters relating to any college opting for 'Sanskrit' as an Elective subject under +2 Science stream is to be deferred till a decision in the matter is taken by the Government.
- xi) Separation of laboratory between Junior and Degree College is necessary. Similarly improvement of Science laboratory for opening of Honours subject is essential and has to be certified before grant of FTR for any new Honours subject.
- xii) At present, there are 35 Self-Financing +2 Science Junior Colleges functioning in the Municipal limits of Bhubaneswar. It was reported that there are applications

for starting 25 more +2 (Junior) Residential Science Colleges in and around Bhubaneswar. As there are a large no. of vacant seats in existing Residential Colleges and as starting of 25 new Colleges would require a large number of trained teachers/Lecturers, the committee felt that giving opening permission to such large number of Junior Science Colleges would not be in the interest of education. Secondly, there seems to be no felt need to start so many new Junior Colleges in the Capital City when feeder High Schools are limited.

- xiii) The HPC observes that in the interest of students and their future, the colleges should have separate land recorded in their name as per provisions of O.E. Act, 1969. Some colleges are taking the plea that the Educational Agency (EA) has got the land but it is seen that the same EA is operating more than one educational institution over the same plot of land. So for the interest of the students one year time is allowed (till 30.06.2010) to all EAs to record separate land in the name of the college/institution failing which no further recognition shall be allowed to the EA. The concerned EA should file an affidavit before the PA to that effect after which conditional recognition shall be accorded in favour of these colleges/institutions.
- xiv) It is decided to accord permission to professional colleges either with minimum permission of 60 seats if one course is permitted to open or with minimum of 30 seats each if two courses are permitted to open to make the colleges viable.
- xv) Permission for opening of Honours subject would be given to a college, which has M.Phil/Ph.D. qualified teachers having completed minimum 05 years of service in that college.
