

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF HIGH POWER COMMITTEE
CONSTITUTED VIDE GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. 15641/HE DATED
01.05.2004 HELD ON 13.01.2009 & 14.01.2009 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE OFFICE
CHAMBER OF COMMISSIONER-CUM-SECRETARY TO GOVERNMENT,
DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

1. The meeting of the High Power Committee constituted vide Government Notification No.15641/HE dated 01.05.2004 was held under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Department of Higher Education in his office chamber to consider the proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of general/professional colleges under Section-5 and 6 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969. The Special Secretary to Government in Higher Education Department attended this Committee meeting as a Special invitee as per the desire of the Chairperson.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education and the Chairperson of the Committee while initiating the discussion indicated that altogether 186 proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of General and Professional Colleges were placed before the committee for consideration. After detailed discussion following decisions were taken.

2. **Grant of Temporary Recognition:**

The Department had received 66 proposals for grant of temporary recognition in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. After detailed discussion the committee allowed 62 cases and rest 04 cases were deferred. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-A.**

During discussion it was observed that some self financing +2 Science colleges are running with part time lecturers. It was also observed that some Agencies are running both +2 and Professional college in the same building. Hence the R.D.Es. are requested to verify the same while conducting inspection for the purpose and specify the land and infrastructure for the Colleges.

3. **Professional Colleges:**

Altogether 11 proposals were received from Director, Higher Education in respect of Private Professional Colleges. After detailed discussion the committee decided to allow 05 cases and rest 06 cases were deferred.

The list of proposals allowed/deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-B.**

During discussion it was observed that Professional Colleges are running with number of courses within the limited accommodation and managing with part time lecturers which is not permissible. Hence the Director, Higher Education is requested to ensure that the professional colleges shall appoint permanent faculty and check the accommodation facilities with reference to the courses permitted.

4. **Opening of New Stream:**

Proposals for opening of new stream in 12 (+2 and +3) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion the committee allowed 03 cases and deferred rest 09 cases for the reasons stated against each proposal placed at Annexure-C. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-C.**

5. **Opening of Honours:**

Proposals for opening of Honours for different subjects in 11 (+3) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion the committee allowed 08 cases and rest 03 cases were deferred for the reasons stated against each proposal placed at Annexure-D. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-D.**

6. Increase of Seats:

Proposals for increase of seats in 06 (+2) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion, the committee allowed 04 cases with necessary modification wherever required, 02 cases were rejected indicating the reasons against each of the college. The list of cases allowed/rejected is placed at **Annexure-E**.

7. Opening of New Subject:

Proposals for opening of new subject in 20 (+2 and +3) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion the committee allowed 11 cases, 07 cases were deferred and 02 proposals were rejected. The list of cases allowed/deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-F**. Since C.H.S.E. has introduced elective subject, it is decided to allow five optional subjects where 64 seats have been permitted in +2 wing and C.H.S.E is required to take action accordingly.

8. Restoration of Examination Centre of Private Colleges:

The Standing Committee earlier recommended to cancel the Examination Centres of 102 colleges for a period of 10 years, those who were found adopting malpractice in C.H.S.E. Examination. As per the said recommendation the H.P.C. in its meeting dated 06.07.2007 cancelled the Examination Centres of such colleges for a period of 10 years. Again the Standing Committee in its report dated 11.03.2008 have recommended that examination centres involving malpractices should be cancelled for three years in stead of ten years.

After thread bare discussion on the matter, the committee agreed with the opinion of the Standing Committee. Further it was decided that hence forward any college found indulged in malpractice shall be de-recognized for a period five years. The Chairman, C.H.S.E. is requested to take action accordingly.

9. Grant of Temporary/Permanent Recognition to Sanskrit Colleges:

All together 38 cases in respect of Sanskrit Colleges were discussed by the Committee. After detailed discussion the Committee allowed 33 cases, rejected 03 cases and deferred 02 cases. The cases which are allowed/deferred/rejected is placed at **Annexure-G**.
